#### NAME OF PROPOSED PROCEDURE OR COURSE OF TREATMENT

### Patent processus vaginalis ligation (left side)

A **patent processus vaginalis ligation** is an groin operation which involves draining a collection of fluid in the scrotum (hydrocele) and tying closed a channel in the groin (processus vaginalis) to stop fluid re-collecting.

#### THE INTENDED BENEFITS

To drain a collection of fluid around a testicle (hydrocele) and close up the connection between the abdomen and the scrotum so that it does not recur.

#### ANAESTHETIC OPTIONS

General anaesthesia.

#### SERIOUS- OR FREQUENTLY OCCURRING RISKS

##### Immediate risks

Surgical care during the coronavirus (COVID-19) pandemic, Damage to spermatic cord.

##### Early risks

Discomfort, Swelling and bruising, Haematoma (collection of blood), Wound infection.

##### Late risks

Recurrence, Testicular atrophy.
